

**Terms to Use
of Tourist Information Internet Service
"Any Type Tour" (further – Terms)**

1. General Provisions

- 1.1 This document is an agreement (further - Agreement) between Internet service Any Type Tour (further - ATT) and Internet users (further - the User) wishing to use tourist information service, which is located at: [http:// www. any-type-tour.com](http://www.any-type-tour.com) under the provisions of these Terms.
- 1.2 These Terms can be changed by ATT without any notice. The new version of the Terms enter into force upon its placing on the Internet at the given address in this paragraph, unless otherwise provided by the new Term's versions.
- 1.3 When Service is having started to use, User confirms that he has taken all Conditions, without any reservations and exceptions. User by using the service confirms that he has a reasonable degree of right, legal capacity and has the right to take these Terms.
- 1.4 If he disagree with any provisions of these Terms, the User has no right to use the Service. If ATT had made any changes in the Terms with which the User does not agree, the User must stop using Service.

2. Right of ownership

- 2.1. ATT is the owner of Website located at the domain <http://www.any-type-tour.com> (further - Website), and any subdomains of this domain, all rights to all objects on this site including database, as well as the related code, data and materials, appearance, design and organization of the Site, the content, code, data and materials of the Site, including but not limited all and any copyright trademark rights, patent rights, database rights, moral rights, special rights and other rights to intellectual property. Using Site it does not gives to User ownership rights to any content, code, data or materials to which he can get access on the Site.
- 2.2 Ownership of cards that are used to display information by Service belongs to American public Google Inc.
- 2.3 Copying or distributing information from Site its components, or to change the Site and publication information on other websites - **is forbidden** without taking permission from ATT to provide the information and all copyrights and guidance of author's identity, saved unchanged. This accommodation backlinks for Service is required, unless otherwise indicated.

3. The rights and obligations of User

- 3.1 User agrees to follow these Terms and timely familiarize themselves with the current version of the Terms.
- 3.2 User agrees not to examine the code, not to decompile, disassemble Service and not to modify Service only except modifications content with permission, and not to create derivative products based on Service or its parts.
- 3.3 The User has right of noncommercial use of all tools and functionality

provided by Service and developed through the Services: mobile application, widgets, API.

- 3.4 User can use the services in charge of commercial or non-commercial purposes upon reaching individual agreements with Service.
- 3.5 Using information and other Service elements may only within functional proposed by Service. No Service elements and no any information contained in Service can be used without prior permission. Term "using" includes: reproduction, copying, processing, distribution on any basis, etc.

4. It is forbidden for the user:

- 4.1 Use the Service in any way that could prevent to his proper functioning.
- 4.2 To conduct the intellectual analysis of data, to use program-robots, automated scripts or similar methods to collect information or a different kind cooperation with the objects of the Service.
- 4.3 To copy, store data on local media and scan, or any other way to try to get / keep / manage information of the Service, except as provided in point 3 of these Terms.

5. Rights and obligations of ATT

- 5.1 If User violets applicable Terms, ATT may unilaterally, in whole or in part, restrict the User's access to the Service without prior notice, delete all user's data and user can be refused in further service delivery, ATT is not responsible for any damage that may be caused by such actions.
- 5.2 ATT reserves the right to fully or partially limit Service functionality of technical, technological, prophylactic or other reasons, in its sole discretion without prior notice.
- 5.3 ATT has the right to use user's data in accordance with point 9 of these Terms.

6. The protection of User personal information and personal data (further - Personal Information)

- 6.1 ATT is serious about User Privacy information. We generally accepted follow standards to protect such information, including and without limitation:
 - providing limited access to personal information of User and only those employees will have who need it to provide the services to User;
 - employees signing Non-Disclosure Agreement (NDA) to protect Users and other confidential information;
 - partners - providers are signing NDA to ensure confidentiality of User Personal information and prevent its unauthorized use.

7. Trademarks

- 7.1 The trademarks, logos, markers, signs and maintenance services, trade names, etc. (further - "Trademarks") presented on Site or materials on this Website are registered and unregistered and other

owners can not use them without their permission.

- 7.2 On the Website nothing contained should not be treated as a transfer by refusing or by other way any license or right to use, any trademark without the written permission of ATT or a third person - the owners of such rights.
- 7.3 User's use of any trademark in violation of the relevant rights is strictly prohibited.

8. Abandonment from responsibility

- 8.1 Service is provided on its terms "as is". Information that received on the Site may be incomplete or inaccurate and may do not match to user's expectations and by its nature may be subject to partial changes and updates.
- 8.2 Service Rights holders are not responsible for possible damages that may be caused to User or any third person using Service.

9. Privacy

- 9.1 When User is taking Terms, he confirms his consent to processing his Personal Information by Service.
- 9.2 When user is using the service the following user's information, is processing:
 - registration information provided by User in the process of using Service (surname, first name, middle name, e-mail, phone number, identification information which is designed to confirm the identity of user);
 - cookies files;
 - IP-address;
 - all information obtained in connection User with Service.
- 9.3 ATT made user Personal information any ways in order to give all service provision to user (identification, authentication, transmission of information materials for user subscriptions, respond for User's letters and other actions which are time to time necessary for service provisioning).
- 9.4 User's information collection and processing which provided in Terms, may be carried out on the territory of Ukraine or any other country where is presented infrastructure of ATT (branches, subsidiaries, representative offices). When user is using Service and providing information to ATT he gives consent to this type of collection and processing information outside of Ukraine.
- 9.5 Except the cases provided in paragraph 9 of these Terms, ATT will not disclose, distributes and sells personal user's information to any third person or parties.
- 9.6 ATT has the right to transfer Personal information fully or partially to third persons without notice of User in the following cases:
 - to persons in charge, possession or ownership is the service transferred to;
 - to persons who are associated / affiliated with ATT, such as companies that can be hired to ATT for process payments, storing data, hosting, marketing research, audit and orders execution;

- to the new owner of Service;
 - to other Service users if in Service provided corresponding functionality.
- 9.7 Service site may attend Internet codes of third persons, so third persons could get data referred in point 9.2. These Internet resources are:
- systems of collecting Service statistics of visits (such as Google Analytics, etc.);
 - social plugins (blocks) of social networks (Facebook, etc.);
 - systems of banners (AdRiver etc.);
 - other resources.
- 9.8 The User has right to protect his personal information provided by the Law of Ukraine.
- 9.9 Under the current legislation of Ukraine, User has right to revoke his agreement to processing personal data by:
- deleting the information previously posted on the Site;
 - request removal of user's data by sending info to the address: info@any-type-tour.com.
- 9.10 Opening Personal Information which is provided by User can be made only according to current legislation of Ukraine at the request of court, law enforcement, in other cases provided by law of Ukraine.
- 9.11 ATT reserves right to provide user's Personal information in cases where it is required or permitted by law.
- 9.12 ATT on their own behalf may send to User advertising and informational email notifications about new services, products and other information that may be interesting to User. If User does not wish to receive advertising materials via e-mail, he can change setting in a private page.
- 9.13 Access to Personal Information that was previously provided, its view and edit user can get on User private page.

10. Use "cookies" and other technologies

10.1 ATT uses "cookies" for registration Users of service, individualization and optimization of the site. "Cookies" – these are small text files that are saved on computer disk. Each file has information (including personal data), which subsequently can be read by web server of domain that issued to user this "cookies". Particular, in "cookie" is written the date and time of web page visit, login, session ID, history visit.

"Cookies" make Site using easier for Users in many ways, including:

- "cookies" save time by eliminating needs to multiple enter the same information;
- "cookies" allow Site to recognize registered users after their repeated visits and provide access to results of previous searches and private page;
- "cookies" help to protect user's security by checking information that user enters when logging and to prevent fraud.

10.2 We put effort in order to make this site as easy as possible to use. Our

goal – to make user's service more individual. With this goal ATT may cooperate with third parties who use "cookies" on the Site with following purposes:

- for accounting and analysis total site usage and volume statistical information from user;
- to record users' behavior on Site, such as visiting pages, filling forms and services purchase;
- for traffic estimates for activity accounting;
- for analytical researches and diagnostic Site working capacity in order to improve Site and our services;
- for determining users that come to site through a link from affiliated entities sites, our partners or sponsored links.

10.3 User can allow or disallow to take "cookies". Most browsers automatically accept "cookies" but, as a rule, user can modify browser setting to prohibit their using. If User block "cookies", maybe he will not be able to register or use other interactive features of our Site and Services, which are using "cookies", but may be possible for site navigation.

11. Final Provisions

- 11.1 ATT has right to make maintenance work on site with a temporary Service suspension.
- 11.2 In case of force - majeure circumstances, accidents or failures in hardware - software complexes of third parties, or acts of third parties aimed at suspension or Service termination, the Service can be terminated without prior notice.
- 11.3 ATT has discretion to restrict user access to Service (or any features of Service, if it is technically possible) in repeated violation of these Terms or apply to User other measures to comply with law or rights and legitimate interests of third person and ATT.
- 11.4 The failure by ATT of User 's violation or third party provisions of the Terms will not prevent ATT right to take appropriate actions to protect its interests later.
- 11.5 These terms and conditions regulated and construed in accordance with the current legislation of Ukraine. Questions are not covered by these Conditions shall be settled according to current legislation of Ukraine.
- 11.6 If one or more provisions of these Terms are invalid or have no legal effect, this shall not affect to validity or applicability of other provisions of the Terms.
- 11.7 These terms and conditions written in: Ukrainian, Russian, English, and Polish, located on the Site pages. If text of Terms is different in another language with their Ukrainian-language version, the Ukrainian-language version of these Terms has to be applied.
- 11.8 Users or other person, who believe that their rights and interests are infringed upon the ATT actions, can send the claim to address: info@any-type-tour.com. Examination of claims dealing a Technical Support ATT according to the general procedure for considering

requests, which received.
